Fruit for our 2016 Three Sister's Chardonnay is sourced from the organic Marimar Estate's Don Miguel Vineyard which is located in the southwest corner of the Russian River Valley. The fruit is grown in a cool microclimate which benefits from Pacific Ocean coastal fog.

The wine is aged in a combination of stainless steel and used French oak barrels. The old-world winemaking technique of batonnage, the French term for stirring the lees, provides a balanced wine with a beautifully silky mid palate.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2016 Kelleher "Three Sisters" Chardonnay is a non-malolactic Chardonnay that offers a lively nose with the aromas of stone fruit, Asian pear and pineapple. The mouthfeel is full bodied, rich and broad with a balanced acidity that leads to a long lingering finish. Enjoy now and over the next four years.
